**Consul General Tong Xiaoling Visited CITPS**

On March 31, 2022, Consul General of the People’s Republic of China in Vancouver Mme. Tong Xiaoling visited Canada International Trade Promotion Society (CITPS), accompanied by Economic & Commercial Counsellor Yu Shanjun and Consul Liu Rongyuan.



During the trip, Consul General Tong had a specialized meeting with the CITPS representatives led by its President Jeannie Cheng and Vice President Leo Liu, followed by a visit to the 50N Natural Ecology Group and the Busy Bee International Group.



At the meeting, Consul General Tong appreciated the long-standing efforts of CITPS in promoting China-Canada bilateral cooperation, especially in organizing local enterprises to participate in the China International Import Expo (CIIE) over last four years. She encouraged CITPS to further their efforts to advance bilateral economic and trade cooperation and contribute to the normalization of bilateral relationship. Consul General Tong briefed the CITPS delegates on China’s recent economic performance, new development concept, the “dual carbon ”strategy, new measures of higher level opening up as well as prospects of China-Canada economic and trade cooperation. She stressed that China is implementing the new

development concept, building a new development pattern, promoting comprehensive green transformation of economic and social development, striving to achieve carbon peak by 2030 and carbon neutrality by 2060,



which will bring new opportunities to the rest of the world including Canada. As the economies of China and Canada are highly complementary, enterprises should grasp these opportunities to tap cooperation potentials and achieve greater win-win results. The Consulate General will continue to provide support and services to all business associations and enterprises within its full capacity.



Jeannie Cheng, and Leo Liu made an introduction to CITPS and the plan of organizing the 5<sup>th</sup> CIIE exhibitors. They promised to continue to play the role as a “Civic Economic Ambassador” and build CITPS into a more convenient platform for the economic and trade exchange between Chinese and Canadian enterprises.

Other member enterprise representatives highlighted their own businesses related to China respectively. Many of them said that they are beneficiaries of the CIIE and are full of confidence in the Chinese market and the new opportunities brought by China’s development. They expressed their willingness to participate in CIIE in coming years and contribute more to the Canada-China trade and friendship between the two peoples. Then, Counsellor Yu Shanjun responded to the comments and suggestions raised by the representatives with regard to CIIE application process improvement, policy support for SMEs participation, prompt provision of China’s latest economic and trade regulations, as well as timely update on Epidemic prevention and control measures and visa application policies.

During the visit to the 50N Natural Ecology Group, Consul General Tong complimented the effort by the company for their service to China-Canada trade through international logistics and for undertaking social responsibility. She anticipated early success of the company in the field of biological pharmacy, benefiting mankind.

While visiting the Busy Bee International Group, Consul General Tong expressed that cross-border e-commerce and overseas warehouse is a new mode of international trade and logistics with



great potential. She encouraged the Busy Bee Group and other peer enterprises to be more successful in this field, making greater contributions to the China-Canada trade.
